## *specialist team assist seic*

In tandem with the current PMT support services provided to Sakhalin Energy Investment Company (SEIC) Lunskeye OPF, Kentz Russia has been asked to provide a specialist team of engineers and ex-inspectors for the commissioning of the SEIC offshore platform, LUN-A.

Located 15 km off the north-eastern coast of Sakhalin Island, LUN-A is a drilling and production platform with minimum processing facilities. LUN-A extracts oil condensate and gas which is then sent to the onshore Lunskeye OPF for separation and treatment before being piped to the LNG plant in the south

of the island for final processing and offloading.

The LUN-A platform is designed for year-round operation in harsh climatic conditions and is built to withstand rough seas, severe ice and high seismic activity.

Peter Ross, Kentz Russia Country Manager, noted "The fact that we have been asked to provide these offshore services is an acknowledgement of the quality work that Kentz has consistently produced for SEIC on Sakhalin. We look forward to developing our relationship with this valued client."
